V. Old Business

- Dog Licensing
 - Mr. Fagerholm and Mr. Cleveland worked together to draft changes to the PWC Code and with Ms. Rocio.

- Mr. Fagerholm made a motion to send the dog license proposed language to the Finance Director for their office to take the language from there. Motion Passed.
- Mr. Cleveland explained that the difference in funding being received with this new ability for owners to purchase 3yr license is negligible and should not negatively impact Animal Services annual budget.
- Zoning Pet Store Directive
 - Ms. Shott sent memorandum to Supervisor Boddye's Office. His office sent it to County Attorney. They are looking at the following actions:
 - 1) Changing code to allow Animal Control Officers to inspect Pet Stores
 - 2) Investigating how to update zoning and/ or code similar to other localities.
- Pitbull Subcommittee: Ms. Haufler provided an update on action points taken according to the priorities set for the pitbull subcommitte last Fall:
 - Spoke with 2 different galleries to create an art exhibition in late summer, with theme of pitbull awareness in order to fund a spay and neuter clinic for pitbull PWC residents.
 - Connected with Arts Council and met 2 artists that are willing to feature their art in the expo. As well as a school arts contact to bring students to participate.
 - Got information from tshirt fundraising company to help fundraising efforts for the initiative.
 - The subcommittee is still investigating ways to route funding to an outside 501c3 to handle donations for the spay and neuter clinic initiative.

VI. New Business

- Roberts Rules of Order:
 - The AAC will follow the Roberts Rules of Order in order to have more efficient meetings and reduces arguments, because AAC members will be speaking directly to Chair by making a motion.
- Loudon County Non-Led Shot
 - Ms. Bright, Ms. LoBalbo, Mr. Clevland are working to see how might the PWC Police use non-led shot by researching how Loudon County is implementing this ammunition.
 - Goal is to have non-led shot available to police officers
 - This adhoc committee will meet with the PWC Police Dept by end of April to understand how the Police Dept could move to this ammunition.

 - Ms. Bright will work on establishing a presentation series within the PWC Libraries
- Animal Service Center Restored Space

- Mr. Cleveland is working on receiving bids to complete the build for the restored space. This is larger space for farm animals and family of domesticated animals.
